Logistics

The city Bolzano/Bozen is located directly on the Brenner Motorway, one of the most important European traffic veins for the transport of both goods and people. The first connecting roads of this route were laid by the Romans ("pons drusi"= Bolzano/Bozen). Because of this particularly favourable geographical location, the city of Bolzano/Bozen became one of the most important trade centres of the alpine region.

Motor- and Railways

The Brenner Pass remains the most heavily travelled transportation route in the entire alpine region: Some 200 trains travel the railway line Munich - Rome over the Brenner each day, and thousands of cars and lorries travel the Brenner Motorway A 22. Overall, the road and railway connections are very good and efficient.

Flight Connections

The Bolzano/Bozen Dolomites Airport is just 4 km away from the city centre. At the moment, there are four flights daily to Rome, as well as two daily flights to Milan Malpensa. The new, local airline "Air Alps" also offers chartered flights to major European airports.

Train connections with major cities north and south of the Alps

The main railway Verona-Bolzano/Bozen-Brenner-Innsbruck-Munich allows for fast connections with all major cities both north and south of the Alps. The Bolzano/Bozen train station is located in the centre of town, just ten minutes by foot from the EURAC Convention Center

- MeBo Motorway from Merano/Meran.

Connections and Public Transportation


The city of Bolzano/Bozen has an extensive and developed network of bus connections, which connect the station not only with the rest of the city itself, but also with the surrounding area.

Taxis can be found at the train station, airport, and fairgrounds, as well as at other well-frequented locations. Another transportation feature of the city is its system of three aerial cable cars, which connect the centre with higher-lying areas.
